Background

- Late 2016 came out a law which lets the National archives of Finland to dispose original manifestations if certain conditions are fulfilled
- In the beginning of July came out a letter of intent which stated that
 - All the public administration material which should be archived will be archived in digital form
 - All the analogue material which administrative organizations still have will be digitized till the end on 2029

Present vs. target

- Present
 - 60 mill. pictures (~3-6 shelf kilometers)
 - Old material
 - 1999-2017
 - This years estimate 18 million pictures
- Target
 - At least 171 shelf kilometers (includes only permanently preserved records)
 - Estimated that most of the material is printed (1970->)
 - During 2019-2030
